Purpose	Provide policies and procedures pursuant to Act 7562, Bill No. 30-0017 enable the Department of Finance to pay the Virgin Islands Water a Power Authority (WAPA) from the Single Payer Utility Fund for the elec- and water utility bills of departments, agencies and instrumentalities of Government of the Virgin Islands that are supported by the General Fur		
Policies	 The Department of Finance (DOF) will make payments to WAP the electric and water utility bills of departments, agencies, instrumentalities of the Government of the Virgin Islands tha supported by the General Fund. Monies deposited into the Single Payer Utility Fund are to reravailable until expended and may be used to pay for electric water utility bills, regardless of what fiscal year the services wincurred. The Single-Payer Utility Fund shall consist of appropriated mot that have been released and deposited in the operating accour departments, agencies, and instrumentalities of the Governmet the Virgin Islands for the purpose of paying their respective eleand water bills. The Fund shall also consist of any funds appropriated by legislature and allotted by the Office of Management and Budge such purpose. 		
Responsibilities	Departments, agencies, and instrumentalities supported by the General Fund for electric and water utility bills shall: • Identify primary and secondary contact persons in each departer		
	 or agency responsible for verifying the electric and water utility charges and assisting WAPA with crediting the various account Establish electronic access and/or electronic billing with WAF accordance with the enclosed joint DOF/WAPA memorand dated December 4, 2015. 		
	 Verify and approve electric and water utility bills, to increconciliation of meter numbers with respective billing statement o <u>NOTE</u>: Unless a discrepancy in billing exists that requirements in the provided of the provided o		
	 Maintain copies of electric and water utility bills or statements; 		

 NOTE: Unless a discrepancy in billing exists that requires written notification to DOF and/or WAPA, copies of electrical and water utility bills (or any statement evidencing reconciliation of said bills) should be filed in accordance with the record and retention policy of the respective department, agency, and instrumentality. Contact WAPA upon receiving electronic notification from DOF of the amounts paid on their behalf for electricity and water per district. Communicate directly with WAPA to validate which accounts to apply the payments received from the Single Payer Utility Fund. Process payments to WAPA for their Federal or Special Fund portion of electric and water bills owed. Coordinate with WAPA promptly to resolve any billing dispute, whereby DOF will pay the undisputed portion of the bill when due. Seek to reprogram funds or obtain a supplemental budget via 0MB in the event the allotted funds are not sufficient to cover utility services in any budget year; and, Liquidate any outstanding encumbrances for electric and water utility bills owed to WAPA related to the General Fund, by no later than December 15, 2016.
 The Department of Finance shall: Process a monthly payment to WAPA for the General Fund portion owed every month. Payment to WAPA for the General Fund portion of the respective electric and water utility bills that have been budgeted and released by 0MB. o NOTE: If the amount released by 0MB exceeds the current balance(s) owed to WAPA, DOF will limit payment to that precise balance. Deposit electronic payments into WAPA bank account by or before the 15th of every month. Transmit an electronic notification of payment amounts to WAPA, per department and district for electricity and water utility bills. Provide departments, agencies, and instrumentalities with an electronic notification of payment amounts per district for electricity and water utility bills. Prepare a monthly statement of all obligations and disbursements from the Fund for payment of electric power bills and submit said statement to the Legislature within thirty days after the close of each month: and, Record all utility bills on behalf of government departments and instrumentalities onto the Enterprise Resource Planning Program System (ERP).
 The Office of Management and Budget shall: Release the appropriations into the Single Payer Utility Fund on a monthly basis for the electric and water utility bills of departments, agencies and instrumentalities of the

 Government of the Virgin Islands that are supported by the General Fund; and, Notify DOF, as well as the respective departments, agencies, and instrumentalities of the Government of the Virgin Islands that are supported by the General Fund of the allotment releases in detail (e, g., orgs, objects, and amounts).
 The Virgin Islands Water and Power Authority shall: Submit an aging report to DOF by the 2nd business day in each month for the electric and water utility bills of departments, agencies, and instrumentalities of the Government of the Virgin Islands that are supported by the General Fund. Cooperate and coordinate with departments, agencies, and instrumentalities of the Government of the Virgin Islands that are supported by the General Fund. Cooperate by the General Fund; and, Apply the appropriate credit(s) to departments, agencies, and instrumentalities of the Government of the Virgin Islands that are supported by the General Fund; upon receipt of payment and assistance from the departments in identifying which accounts is to be paid from the General Fund portion (Single Payer Utility Fund).
